They offer comfort and counsel to those who are grieving the death of a loved one and serve as a trusted resource for crisis support in our community. Since 1978, The Elizabeth Hospice has touched the lives of more than 160,000 individuals in San Diego and Southwest Riverside Counties.

A vital part of their mission is ensuring that anyone in need of grief support can access it, regardless of financial circumstances or how their loved one died. This includes accidents and self-inflicted trauma. Services are available for little or no charge thanks to the generosity of our community. A hospice patient affiliation is not required to receive any of their grief services.
